### NOTES ON THE SICK

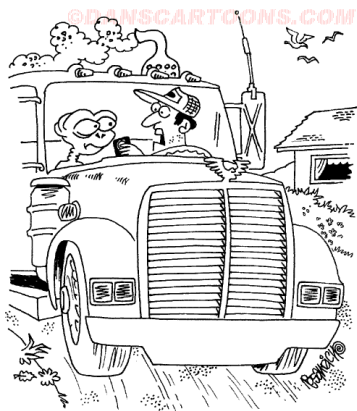
