

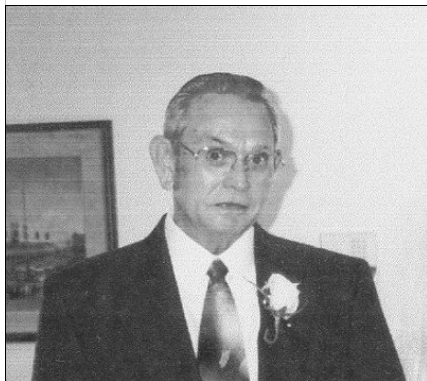

ROSSVILLE — Dale Tyson Daniel, 68, passed away Wednesday, Aug. 31, 2005, at his residence.

He was born in Summerdale, Ala., to the late William Abel and Zuma Burns Daniel, and was raised in Winter Haven, Fla., before he moved to the area in 1978 he drove for Roadway Express in Memphis, Tn. He was a road driver in Chattanooga, Tn until he retired after 24 years of service.

He served in the U.S. Army and was a member of the American Legion and Masonic Lodge in Brainerd.

He was preceded in death by several brothers and sisters.
